Welcome to the Gothic House!

This medieval house was built in the beginning of the 14th century. It partially collapsed in 1996 and was reconstructed a few years later in line with its original architectural style. Note its singular three-lobed windows typical of the Grande Région; a similar window style can be found in cities like Trier (DE) or Metz (FR).

Please take good care of the property and leave it in the same state as you found it upon arrival, for the next visitor(s) to enjoy it in the same way 😊

3. Maintenance and cleaning

The house is cleaned thoroughly before your arrival and after your checkout. In case of a longer stay, the house will be regularly cleaned by the TRIFOLION team and towels will be regularly replaced. Please keep the house orderly to facilitate cleaning the rooms. Cleaning items are at your disposal in the house for small cleaning tasks.

4. Keys and safety

Please make sure to close the windows and to lock the door carefully upon leaving the house. Make sure to keep the door locked at night for your own safety.

HOUSE RULES

- 1. SMOKING IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN INSIDE THE HOUSE. THIS INCLUDES SMOKING THROUGH AN OPEN DOOR OR WINDOW.** You can smoke in front of the house and are politely asked to dispose of cigarette butts in the ashtray outside.
2. Any loss or damage to the property caused by guests must be immediately communicated to the TRIFOLION staff.
3. The TRIFOLION team is not responsible for the safety of the artist(s) personal belongings, valuable items, artistic or material work. Artist(s) are advised to consult their insurers for coverage of such items.
4. No animals, unsanitary articles, strong smelling, inflammable, explosive, corrosive, toxic or dangerous articles may be brought into the house. No burning of items (including candles) or ignition of items or fireworks, firecrackers, or use of open flames is permitted.
5. It is forbidden to add or to modify electrical installations or to use additional electrical equipment such as electrical heaters, electrical stoves, cooking devices, microwave ovens, etc.
6. Noisemaking, playing music loudly, excessive drinking as well as gatherings are forbidden in the house, particularly between 10 pm and 6 am.
7. Disorderly behavior or non-compliance with the rules and regulations may result in eviction as well as financial liability for any damage caused
